## 2. Team Competition Photographer(s): New process this year

One person per team will be allowed in the competition field area with their team to be the team photographer. On Thursday afternoon, April 3, identification badges along with a set of guidelines for the photographers will be issued. These badges must be worn in a visible location for field access, are yours to keep and are good for both Friday and Saturday, so don't lose them. You may rotate the photographers, but remember only <u>ONE</u> is allowed to come onto the field with the team and they <u>MUST</u> be wearing an identification badge.

## 3. Midwest Regional Media Crew: NEW this Year!

Student team members can become part of our new Regional Media Crew! Each day a different crew of three students will be issued special media passes that allows them to be Event Photographers / Videographers with the mission of capturing those special moments and highlights of the Midwest Regional.

The Media Crew for the day will meet before opening ceremonies, receive their assignments and their Media Pass for that day. In the late afternoon / early evening the Crew will meet again to turn in their photos / videos and discuss the day. Pictures will be used on the website, a linked photo sharing site, twitter and facebook. Photo / video credit will be given.

- Note if you have a request for a specific day (Thurs, Fri, or Sat), please indicate which.
- Those selected will be notified by e-mail on Friday March 28, 2014.
- If you are chosen you <u>must</u> sign up in VIMS, under Midwest Regional, select "other" then type in MWR Media Crew under preferences.
