Call for 2014 FRC Regional Event Student Ambassadors:

The Central Illinois Regional Planning Committee requests that each team attending the Central Illinois Regional from February 27th to March 1st select two FRC team members to serve as Ambassadors for FIRST during the three days of competition. Do not select members of your drive team, chairman's presenters, pit crew or other critical positions who will need to be available to your team. If your team is short-handed, you are not required to select anyone. Students ambassadors will need to be ready and available from 8:30 to 10 am on Friday February 28th morning to escort the VIP's when they come into the dome at the conclusion of their presentation.

Ambassador Responsibilities:

- Serve as tour guides for visitors at the competition. Ambassadors will work to escort VIPs, potential sponsors, educators, and/or groups of students visiting our competition. If you are a rookie team, we will try to pair your student with one who has previous FIRST experience.
- Provide information to guests as they enter the arena.
- Must be available to attend the training meeting on Thursday, February 27th between 1:00 and 3:00 PM.

Ambassador Qualifications:

- Student should be a veteran (not their first year) with a good knowledge base of FIRST, and thorough understanding of this year's game.
- Good communicator and works equally well with adults and children.
- Possess the ability to talk with guests about the FIRST experience, its benefits, and why they are involved in FIRST. They will be giving tours of the pit areas.
- Dress and behavior positively reflect FIRST and the Central Illinois Regional.
- Wear their team uniform and a nametag provided by the Regional Planning Committee that distinguishes them to guests.
